Extremity Games 6: Extreme Sports for Athletes with Disabilities
Hosting athletes from around the world and wounded warriors

Rochester Hills, MI (September 7, 2010) - Extremity Games 6 (eX6) dates are set for 2011. Extremity Games Motocross is scheduled for May 28 in Millington, Michigan and Extremity Games Main Event is scheduled for June 24-25 in San Antonio, Texas. Extremity Games is an extreme sports event including competitions, instructional clinics and exhibitions for athletes with limb loss or limb difference.

Extremity Games Motocross will be broken out into two divisions: Limb Loss (i.e. amputee, etc) and Limb Difference (paraplegic, quadriplegic, etc). Riders will race a Two-Moto format during Baja Acres' Memorial Day race weekend. Athletes will be competing for a cash purse.

Extremity Games Main Event includes competitions and instructional clinics in skateboarding, rock climbing, wakeboarding, sit-boarding, kayaking and mountain biking. Exhibitions include motocross and mixed martial arts.

A full-day of instructional clinics and Athlete Sign-in are set for Friday, June 24 from 9 am – 3 pm at the Texas Ski Ranch in New Braunfels, Texas, which will be followed by the Athlete Sign-in and Welcome Reception at the host hotel from 6-9 pm.

eX6 Main Event Competitions run on Saturday, June 25 from 8 am – 5 pm. Extremity Games concludes Saturday evening with an award ceremony and BBQ at Texas Ski Ranch. All are welcome to join the BBQ awards celebration. Tickets are available on-line or at the door.

Elite and Novice competitions are available at eX6 Main Event. Elite competition athletes will compete for cash prizes, while Novice competition athletes will compete for prizes. Cash prizes will be determined on the amount of participants in each competition/division.

Organized to raise awareness of the abilities of individuals living with limb loss or limb difference to compete in extreme sports, Extremity Games Main Event allows participants to demonstrate skill, persistence and passion while competing for prizes.
